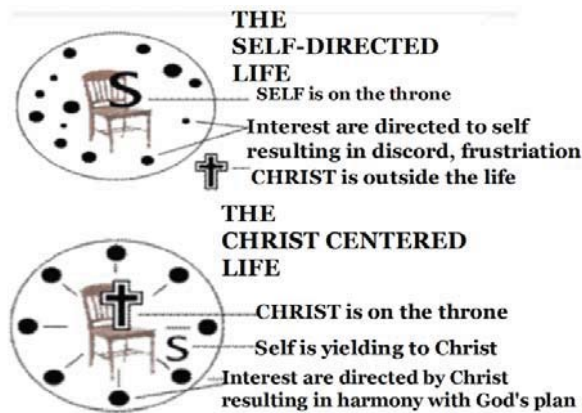


Which circle best represents' your life?
